May 10 –11 Restored vehicles Association Dalby, invite you to Celebrate 30 years. By attending "Cooking with Gas". Bevin has entry forms.

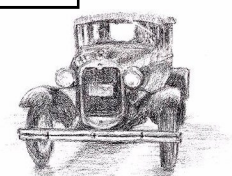

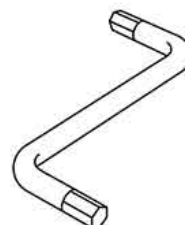
