ELIGIBILITY

All vehicles accepted by any Antique, Veteran, Vintage or Classic Club, be they Motorcycle, Motor Car, Truck, Tractor, Horse-drawn or Self Propelled are eligible. Vehicles for the Sunshine Coast Hub Tour must be registered, complete, and roadworthy. The Antique Car Club of Nambour reserves the right to exclude any vehicle it considers un-roadworthy or does not enter the spirit of the event.

Chassis and Vehicles under restoration are acceptable for the Motorkana and are in fact

welcome and will be classed accordingly.

FORMAT

The Sunshine Coast Hub Tour is designed as a well organized holiday with an antique atmosphere. The pace for the Tours will be leisurely and pleasantly entertaining. Ample time will be allowed for visiting all places of interest. There will be no motoring competitions during the Tours.

Motorkana 72 will be similar to last year and will be Two Days of Events, including a Concours d'Elegance, Hillclimb, Treasure Hunt and Gymkhana. As in previous years movies and other

entertainments will be part and parcel of the Motorkana.

All entries for the Hub Tour are automatically included in the Motorkana. It is not necessary to attend every Tour. You may come for a day, the weekend, or for the week. Hub Tour entries have priority for the Grand Finale Dinner-Dance, where unfortunately there will be a limit of 300 tickets.

TROPHIES

Trophies to the value of approximately \$1,000 will be provided to cover all events and commemorative brass plaques will be given to all competitors.

GRAND FINALE DINNER

A rather fantastic Night of Nights Casual Dinner is being planned to wind up the Sunshine Coast Hub Tour. This evening will take place at the fabulous new "Surfair International Hotel" and it is planned that this will be Queensland's Social Event of the Year. Remember that the first 300 only, will go to "Surfair" for a fabulous evening.

FEES

Entry for SUNSHINE COAST HUB TOUR is \$10.00 per Vehicle (includes Motorkana). Entry for MOTORKANA 72 is \$2.00 per Vehicle. GRAND FINALE DINNER-DANCE, SURFAIR INTERNATIONAL HOTEL is \$5.00 per head. (Competitors and passengers only.) (Children will be catered for separately.)

CLOSING DATE

The closing date for entries in the Sunshine Coast Hub Tour will be the **30th JUNE**, **1972**. Entries for Motorkana 72 will be accepted up to the **31st JULY**, **1972**. The first 150 vehicles ONLY will be accepted for the Hub Tour. Please return entries in the envelope supplied as soon as possible.

LOCATION

Peregian Beach. The Events and Tours will all centre on the Peregian Beach sports oval which is entered off the Coastal Highway approximately 50 yards past the Peregian Beach Motel. The Peregian Beach Caravan Park and Camping Grounds are adjacent to the oval. A picnic ground is also adjacent to the sports oval.

AMENITIES

Toilets are available in the Caravan Park and also at the tennis court shed. Tennis courts are available free . . . contact caravan park caretaker. Swimming pools (free) are in the main shopping centre, opposite oval. The beautiful Peregian Surfing Beach is approximately 300 yards from the oval. The Peregian Beach general store is opposite grounds and a public phone (S.T.D.) is opposite. A licensed bar operates at the bowling club adjacent to the sports oval and all visitors over 21 years are welcome. A visitors' information centre will operate all through the Hub Tour and Motorkana period.

ACCOMMODATION

First class accommodation of all types is available. Self-contained units, motels and an international class hotel are close by. The Peregian Beach Caravan Park will be fully equipped for competitors. Please read the accommodation section of the entry form carefully and print all answers. Accommodation bookings will be in the competent hands of T. M. Burke Pty. Ltd., and you will be notified of all details by them.
